For other categories, participants should follow the genres but there are no limits in topics and content. 5. Only Chinese works will be accepted. There are no word limits.

Students can use words, pictures, videos, etc. to record their reading responses. If students choose to write their reading responses, they should use at least 30 words. 4. The reading responses or comments should be original. 5. No plagiarism is allowed.
Date	<p>Phase 1: 7th October, 2019 – 31st January, 2020</p> <p>Phase 2: 1st February, 2020 – 31st May, 2020</p> <p>Phase 3: 1st June, 2020 – 16th August, 2020</p>
Award	<p>Students who can finished the required amount of reading records will be given an e-badge and certificate.</p> <p>The top 10 students with the most reading records can get the ‘Outstanding Performance Award’. A certificate and \$150 coupon will be given.</p> <p>Best participating schools can also get a certificate and coupons.</p>
